INTRODUCTION: The remainder of chapter 18 deals with the subject of discipline in the family of God (18:15-35). Verses 15-20 look at the proper procedure in dealing with those who wrong us. Sinning against a brother or sister is a matter of great concern to God. The Church is His family. The sinning individual is a "brother" - a genuine believer in Jesus Christ. He is one over whom the angels hall never Show me be around. do fail and discipline.

watch – He is one for whom Christ died – he is one for whom God loves and has willed a perish (18:10-14). Jesus = dealing with "family matters" – discipline within the family. children that experience no discipline in the home and I'll show you children I don't want to If all Christians were perfect there would be no need for verses 15-20.
