## FORTY YEARS IN EGYPT

Exodus 1:1 – 2:15a

**Introduction** The great “heroes” of the Bible, both Old and New Testaments were not different from ordinary men and women except in their faith. What James says about Elijah that he “*was a man with a nature like ours*” can be said about all the Bible heroes, including Moses. A casual reading of Hebrews chapter eleven will confirm that it was their faith that distinguished them above their contemporaries. This was certainly true about Moses as the Faith Hall of Fame (Hebrews 11) states four times that faith was the secret to all that Moses did for God on behalf of His people. God will teach us through His servant Moses, “the believer is the God-filled, the God-moved, the God possessed man; and the work which he affects in the world is not his, but God’s through him.” (F.B. Meyer – Moses).
